Concerned by the impact of the Coronavirus pandemic on vulnerable people living in the parish, we redirected our Social Action Fund to support a range of community initiatives and projects to help and support local residents.

Penzance Council awarded funding to the Solomon Browne Memorial Hall (SBMH) to help support the village community of Mousehole during the Coronavirus pandemic.

The SBMH Charity's key objective is to bring people together as a community. They ordinarily host weekly exercise classes parent and toddler groups, a Farmer's Market and other events such as music gigs, craft workshops and theatre productions.

Following a successful application for emergency funding, Penzance Council awarded SBMH a grant of £1,000.

This funding enabled them to set up a volunteer network to provide essential deliveries like shopping and medication; a telephone helpline; smile bags; and establish their own emergency supplies fund to help those who were unable to leave their home or access cash.

SBMH provided vital support to individuals who needed it the most and brought the whole community together.
