Temporary Prohibition of Vehicular Traffic Order 2023

Notice is hereby given that Cornwall Council intends to make the above Order in exercise of its powers under section 16A of the RTRA 1984 to prohibit the use by vehicular traffic over an area of highway being Battery Road, Alverton Street, Market Jew Street, The Greenmarket, Market Place, Albert Street, Station Road, Chapel Street, Quay Street, Coinagehall Street, The Quay, Green Street, Dock Lane, Promenade, Battery Road, Wharf Road, Under Chapel Yard, Causewayhead, Alverton Street, The Greenmarket, Princes Street, New Street, Queens Square, Clarence Street, Parade Street, Bread Street, Penzance for their entire lengths.

Fun Fair: Battery Road, Penzance 18th June 2023 (00:00 hours) to 26th June 2023 (11:00 hours)

Civic Parade: Alverton Street, Market Place, The Greenmarket, Market Jew Street 18th June 2023 (10:30 to 10:45 hours)

St Johns Eve Torch Lit Procession: Chapel Street and Quay Street 23rd June 2023 (20:00 to 23:59 hours)

Mazey Eve Fireworks and Quay Fair Day: Coinagehall Street, Quay Street, The Quay, Green Street, Dock Lane, Promenade, Battery Road, Wharf Road, Under Chapel Yard and Chapel Street on 23rd June 2023 (20:00 hours to 23:59 hours) and 25th June 2023 (07:00 to 19:00 hours)

Mazey Day: Causewayhead, Alverton Street, The Greenmarket, Princes Street, New Street, Queens Square length, Market Jew Street, Clarence Street, Market Place, Parade Street, Chapel Street, Bread Street for one day on 24th June 2023 (06:00 to 19:00 hours) and Albert Street and Station Road (11:20 to 11:40 hours, 13:20 to 13:40 hours and 15:20 to 15:40 hours) and Morrab Road between Alverton Street and Victoria Place (10:00 to 16:00 hours) and Guildhall Road (10:30 to 15:30 hours)

Quay Fair Day: The Promenade between Morrab Road and Alexandra Road 25th June 2023 (07:00 to 19:00 hours)

Roads Subject to a One Way Restriction

A one way restriction will be imposed on Harbour Court, Access to Abbey Slip and Abbey Slip Penzance between the junctions of Chapel Street and Jennings Street in a north east to south westerly direction from 23rd June 2023 (20:00 hours to 23:59 hours) 24th June 2023 and 25th June 2023 (07:00 hours to 19:00 hours)

Roads Subject to a 10mph Speed Restriction

The Cornwall Council hereby gives notice under Section 14 (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to impose a temporary speed restriction of 10 MPH over an area of highway being Battery Road Penzance for its entire length, Penzance for approximately 70 metres, Coinagehall Street between the junctions of Battery Road and Green Street for approximately 80 metres, Green Street for its entire length for approximately 80 metres, and Under Chapel Yard between the junctions of Green Street and Battery Road for approximately 30 metres from 18th June 2023 (00:00 hours) to 26th June 2023 (11:00 hours)

The Order shall come into operation at 00:00 on the 18th June 2023 and continue until 11:00 on the 26th June 2023.

The Council is satisfied that the Order is needed to facilitate the holding of the following relevant event Golowan Festival.

While the Order is in operation traffic, including bicycle movement, along the highway specified in paragraph 1, will be temporarily prohibited. No personnel, except upon the direction of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle or pedal cycle to enter on, proceed or wait in the length of road described above.

Nothing in the Order will apply to: any police, fire brigade, ambulance or coastguard vehicle, or any personnel on official duty, any vehicle being used for the purposes of an undertaker in an emergency, or traffic associated with the event required within the highway specified above.
