

**Chapel Street Creative CIO**

*'As reported previously, the new floor has now been put down in studio 2 thanks to the Lottery Fund. This has made this space more comfortable and fit for purpose, hugely extending the possibilities for further accessible usage. The next stage is to install an additional toilet and small kitchenette, which will then create a separated standalone space for hire, allowing for multiple users all at the same time (especially when the main building has already been booked and is in use).*

*New regular activities providers include Chichi dance and Tai Chi Movements for Wellbeing. Distance Dances have also extended their regular sessions picking up the shortfall from the loss of regular user, Luna Agile Learning, after their decision to close the organisation.*

*The Charity will soon have the Trustees Annual Report completed for final submission of the accounting for the period July 2024 to June 2025.*

*The Charity is also seeking a development grant to 1) create a performance space in the main hall, and 2) make urgent and necessary repairs to the rest of the windows. In particular, one of the stain glass windows in the rear elevation is in a fragile state, and some much-needed repairs to the pointing at the back of the building. The Charity would love to hear from anyone with contacts and ideas.'*
