Temporary Prohibition and Restriction of Vehicular Traffic Order 2026

1. The Cornwall Council makes this Order in exercise of its powers under Section 16A of the RTRA 1984 to prohibit the use by vehicular traffic over an area of highway being Battery Road, Alverton Street, Market Jew Street, The Greenmarket, Market Place, Albert Street, Station Road, Chapel Street, Quay Street, Coinagehall Street, The Quay, Green Street, Dock Lane, Promenade, Battery Road, Wharf Road, Under Chapel Yard, Causewayhead, Alverton Street, The Greenmarket, Princes Street, New Street, Queens Square, Clarence Street, Parade Street, Bread Street, Penzance for their entire lengths as highlighted by the red dashed line on the plan attached to this Order.
2. The Cornwall Council makes this Order in exercise of its powers under Section 16A of the RTRA 1984 to restrict traffic from travelling in a north east to south westerly direction along Harbour Court and Access to Abbey Slip and Abbey Slip Penzance between the junctions of Chapel Street and Jennings Street Penzance for their entire length whilst a One-Way restriction is in force as highlighted by the blue line on the plan attached to this Order.
3. The Order shall come into operation on at 00:00 on the 21st June 2026 and continue until the 11:00 on the 28th June 2026. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall remain in force on such days and during such times as the appropriate traffic signs are displayed. In this Order 'traffic sign' means a sign of any size, colour and type described or authorised under or having effect as though prescribed or authorised under section 64 of The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
4. The Council is satisfied that the Order is needed to facilitate the holding of the following relevant event Golowan Festival.
5. While the Order is in operation traffic, including bicycle movement, along the Highway specified in Paragraph 1, will be temporarily restricted. No personnel, except upon the direction of a police constable in uniform, cause or permit any vehicle or pedal cycle to enter on, proceed or wait in the length of road described above.

Nothing in the Order will apply to:

- a. Any police, fire brigade, ambulance or coastguard vehicle
- b. Anything done with the permission of or at the discretion of a police officer
- c. Traffic Associated with the event required within the highway specified in paragraph 1
- d. Access to residential properties and businesses will be maintained for all traffic
- e. Pedestrian access to residential properties and businesses will be maintained

Temporary Prohibition and Restriction of Vehicular Traffic Order 2026

1. The Cornwall Council makes this Order in exercise of its powers under Section 16A of the RTRA 1984 to prohibit the use by vehicular traffic over an area of highway being Battery Road, Alverton Street, Market Jew Street, The Greenmarket, Market Place, Albert Street, Station Road, Chapel Street, Quay Street, Coinagehall Street, The Quay, Green Street, Dock Lane, Promenade, Battery Road, Wharf Road, Under Chapel Yard, Causewayhead, Alverton Street, The Greenmarket, Princes Street, New Street, Queens Square, Clarence Street, Parade Street, Bread Street, Penzance for their entire lengths as highlighted by the red dashed line on the plan attached to this Order.
2. The Cornwall Council makes this Order in exercise of its powers under Section 16A of the RTRA 1984 to restrict traffic from travelling in a north east to south westerly direction along Harbour Court and Access to Abbey Slip and Abbey Slip Penzance between the junctions of Chapel Street and Jennings Street Penzance for their entire length whilst a One-Way restriction is in force as highlighted by the blue line on the plan attached to this Order.
