The changes on Market Jew Street (MJS) have been made to create a more welcoming, attractive, and safer, low-traffic town centre. To support this, Cornwall Council will introduce Moving Traffic Enforcement using camera-based Automatic Number Plate Recognition technology to improve compliance with the existing 11 am–4 pm Traffic Regulation Order (TRO). During these hours, only buses and taxis may enter; all other vehicles must avoid MJS.

Measures supporting continued access include:

- Bus services will continue in both directions. The Main Buses are: No. 1/1A, 4/4A, 6, 8, and 16
- Additional Blue Badge parking is available nearby.
- Three new Blue Badge bays have been added on MJS. Vehicles parked before 11 am may stay up to three hours without penalty.
- Free Shop Mobility scooter hire is available at the Wharfside Shopping Centre.
- Upgraded Wharfside lifts now provide improved access from the Wharfside Car Park to MJS for pedestrians, wheelchair users, and mobility scooter users.

These measures help to balance a more pedestrian-friendly street for residents, businesses, and visitors.
